State Farm, Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) and Bliss, Inc. have formed a partnership to bring the Youth-Led Implementation Model of MADD's Protecting You/Protecting Me® (PY/PM) to schools across the country. PY/PM is a SAMHSA Model Program for students in grades 1-5 based on the latest brain research and the impact of alcohol on the developing brain. The Youth-Led Implementation Model of PY/PM is designed to be implemented by high school students enrolled in an upper level, full-year elective class* for credit in which the teacher has received training on the implementation of PY/PM.

*The class can be designated as a peer helping or leadership class or any class that involves service-learning. Classes under the umbrella of Family and Consumer Sciences; Family, Career, and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) courses; and other teacher preparation courses or future teacher/educator courses can be appropriate classes in which to incorporate the program. Do you have a high school class you're not sure is a good fit for PY/PM? Contact us to find out.

The partnership's goal is to establish school sites across the country that will commit to implementing PY/PM and the service-learning projects that are designed to inform the community about the impact of alcohol on the developing brain.

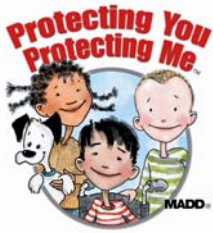
Getting involved is simple! If your school site has the required structure, your school site is eligible for this project. State Farm will fund the training registration fee and materials cost for the high school classroom teacher to attend a youth-led Protecting You/ Protecting Me training and provide the PY/PM curriculum that the high school students use in the elementary school.

Trainings will be held in summer 2008. Please check the PY/PM website, www.pypm.org, for specific training dates and locations.
